April 15th to 19th, 2024


Dance as Invocation April 22nd to 26th, 2024

Based on the working methodology developed by **Nien Tzu Weng** and **Emile Pineault** in their creation More-than-Things (2022), you will play with objects through tasks, restrictions, and scores. You will explore touch, listening, improvisation and composition.
